This week's **Rotary Foundation Thought:** HIV/AIDS projects.

Through a variety of humanitarian grants awarded by The Rotary Foundation, Rotarians around the world have found creative and effective ways to fight the spread of HIV/AIDS and care for its victims. Rotary Districts in Columbia and the US have partnered to receive a Health, Hunger and Humanity (3H) Grant aimed at implementing an HIV/AIDS awareness and prevention campaign in Columbian high schools around Bogota. Through the use of guided mural exhibitions, over 200,000 students were reached with life-saving messages about HIV/AIDS. Separately, in an effort to meet the needs of children orphaned by HIV/AIDS, Rotary clubs in Ethiopia and Spokane Valley Sunrise, USA, obtained a Matching Grant to help provide a used van, clothing, food, furniture, a computer and office supplies to an orphanage serving AIDS orphans in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia.

The opportunities to make a difference are limitless.
