

Meeting Notes - March 23rd, 2016 submitted by Ron Blank, photos by Donna Allen

Guests this morning were Dave Perry, Rotary Club of Duncan, Gill Campbell of Nanaimo North and Alisha Mark, Rotoract incoming President and soon to be Daybreak member.

This Meeting is about World Community Service and Nelson opened the talk with numbers. Over our 20 history, our Rotary Foundation donations exceed \$107,000 and averaged \$5,200 per year with 55% of our members having donated US \$1,000 to become Paul Harris Fellows. These donations then become available to Clubs from our District 5020 and Rotary International to help fund projects. "Rotary making a world of difference."

Ken Hammer discussed the 22 Clubs located north of Victoria forming the Mid Island Group (MIG) World Community Service (WCS). With annual donations from every club, they also help fund our local and international service projects.

Graham Calder says Shelterbox has donated 135,000 shelter kits to 90 countries with our Box # 240 being donated in Chris Everett's name. Recent sites receiving boxes: January to Philippines, October to Maui, Greece for migrants and Nepal in 2015.

Though San Mahara was away, Ken said he has collected about \$10,000 and will be pursue a Rotary Global Grant for a major Nepal project.

Patrick Maguire presented details of our recent Guatemala Project. This year, we funded a cobblestone road connecting Santa Ana de Schaffer to San Lucas, supplied new corrugated roofing for four families, 15 scrub tubs (pilas) and banana plants for their wastewater, school supplies for 20 students and shoes for 40 in need, whilst expending US \$5,500.

Ken described the Ghana projects that have invested over \$100,000, built relationships with their Sunyani Polytechnic College, VIU and RDN, funded the Masters Degree of Vincent. The latest projects will include Bev Hilton's project 2016, funding multiple school renovations with a \$70,000 Global Grant. Nwawsua Schools will receive funding for local construction of 12,000 school desks. Brechin Elementary School students have partnered with a Sunyani school and are developing videos of "The week in the life of a student."

Hence, we should all support our Rotary Foundation to continue our current great work and to fund future projects.

50/50 remained with an unlucky pull by yours truly. That being said, collecting happy bucks rounded off the morning and off we went to do Rotary deeds.
