Guest Speaker Vicki Horsfield

Vicki, a physiotherapist by vocation and a member of the Rotary club of Canada, is the head of a NGO operating in Guatemala under the name Creating Opportunities for Guatemalans. The goal of the organization is to lift Guatemalan children out of poverty through education. Vicki advised that 58% of Guatemalan children live below the extreme poverty line and that 1/2 of the children under the age of five are chronically malnourished. Apparently 30% of children enrolled in primary school don't make grade 6 and 90% of high school kids don't graduate. Most of these children have to drop out of school to help support their families.

Vicki's organization provides school supplies, uniforms, homework support, English training and tutoring to students based on a means test. They operate an after school program that provides the services noted above.

Vicki advised that they need financial support to help pay for:

- Salaries for the part-time staff
- Nutrition program
- Improving living conditions
- Purchase of four sewing machines

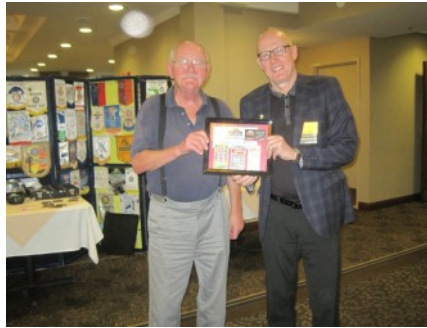
Currently they sponsor 25 students to attend school and 50 students in their after school program. The cost to support and educate a student in primary school is \$30 per month
