Our presentation today was from our Ghana team, which consists of Ken Hammer, Bev Hilton and Susan. They each picked a handful of memorable pictures for the club and shared their experiences with us.

The team landed during the Ghana district conference and were able to meet a variety of local Rotarians from the district.

They explored the local culture, visiting looms for making Kente fabrics, and attended a large market day to experience life in Ghana. Bev was able to even pass some of her culture to Ghana and taught Vincent (one of Rotary Day-breaks previous Ghana contacts) how to make banana bread.



The group toured many medical facilities along their travels:

- Visiting homes to deliver medical supplies.
- Visiting the blood fridge donated from the Mid Island Group.
- Delivering portable ultra sound units to remote areas.

Even meeting a traditional Shaman in a local village.

They assisted with the development of a three-room school house, as it was discovered that in some villages the kids under 10 cannot go to school as the travel distance is to great. As such, they are starting to build a local to help with this issue.

If you would ever want to participate in a international trip and assist in Ghana, please ask any of this year's team members.
