By 2013 the Society recognized that they needed to include a "head liner" to boost the festival. The well known "Canned Heat" provided the recognition and agreed to appear at a cost the Festival could afford.

The Festival then recognized the need to give back to the community so included a fundraising effort for Loaves and Fishes. This year the Festival will again support Loaves and Fishes with cash and food donations.

The Summertime Festival also supports local blues musicians by providing an opportunity to present their music from a "big stage". The Festival this year will include 22 unique acts travelling from all over North America. The Summertime Blues Festival has become a destination tour event.
