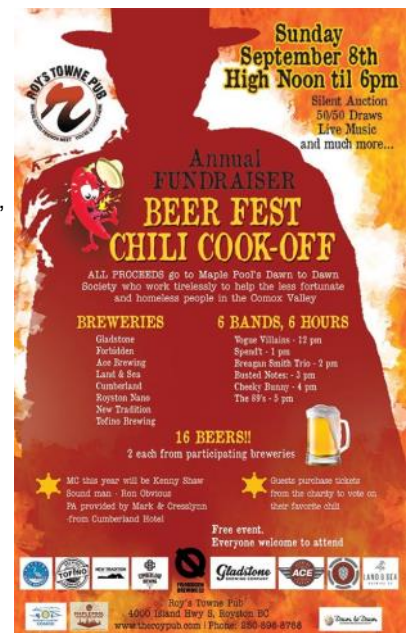

Guest Speakers Ken Hammer and Wayne Peddie

Ken advised that the partnership with our Ghanaian friends started in 2006. It originally was a VIU initiative, but when they came to Nanaimo, Ken invited them to a Rotary meeting and a fireside chat. This connection with Rotary resulted in the chartering of a new Rotary club in Sunyani and many projects in Ghana. Over the years we have been very successful in leveraging our funds with matching federal and Rotary International grants.

This year Ken, Wayne, Bev and two other Rotarians travelled to Ghana in April. They had over 100,000 dollars to invest in the purchase of badly needed hospital equipment in seven rural hospitals. Equipment included incubators, autoclaves, ultrasounds and blood fridges and freezers. They ensure the hospital employees are properly trained to both operate and maintain the donated equipment. Wayne showed numerous pictures of the local Ghanaians, both adults and children and commented how happy and accepting they are.

The plan is to return to Ghana every second year to check on our previous projects and initiate new ones. Our friends from Ghana will be making a trip to Nanaimo this year and Ken advised that we will be looking for members of our club to host our guests.
