Finance committee, which includes Nelson, Terry, Anna, and others will review and possibly look at updating budget. Doug Lum would like to be in that meeting.

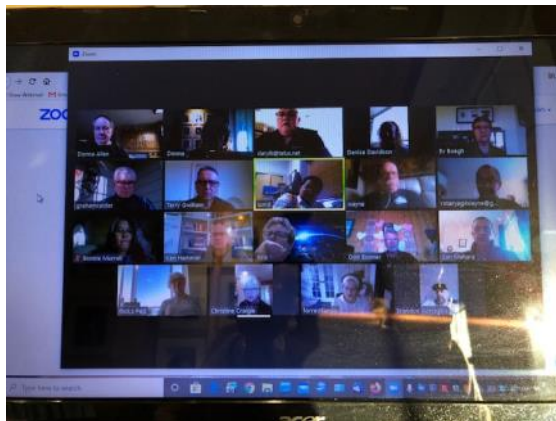
