- ◇ Denise L. introduced our Guest speaker **Ken Hodge**.
Ken – served in the armed services from 1977 to 2010, with order of military merit being just one of many acknowledgments.

Ken is involved in Courageous Companions, which provides military service men and women, veterans, and first responders diagnosed with an operational stress injury to be trained with a service dog. Each Service Dog undertakes specialized training to provide for the needs of the individual for whom they are being trained. The two are then trained together to become a service dog team. Service dogs are an additional treatment option to psychiatric and social support. The dogs have been shown to have a calming effect on PTSD sufferers.

All dogs are certified, as they go through 1yr of training and their certification test. Cost of a dog is \$15,000-\$20,000. They provided over 200 last year .
