President Anna open our Zoom meeting as we have moved away from in-person meetings to meet Covid regulations.

Doug Pearson invoked the words of William Penn, "I expect to pass through this world but once. Any good therefore that I can do, or any kindness or abilities that I can show to any fellow creature, let me do it now. Let me not defer it or neglect it, for I shall not pass this way again."

There were no guests this morning, neither Rotarians, nor guests of Rotarians. This absence included our guest speaker.

Without a guest speaker, President Anna reorganized the agenda to a "club news, discussions and announcement" meeting.

Bonnie provided a Rotary moment announcing that Nigeria is now "Polio free".

Announcements;

Our next bottle drive is scheduled for August 29th, again at Nanaimo Regional Recycling.

New Covid regulations suggest that meetings may be held prior to noon. This could allow us to hold in-person meetings again, however the Executive has determined that staying on Zoom until September is the better plan.

August is Membership and New Club Development month. We are now putting "member spotlights" on our Facebook page. Email Laura if you would like to be a spotlight member with your photo (preferably while in Rotary action) and your thoughts about "what Rotary means to you".

Patrick is working with Ron Blank's family to arrange a garage sale. This will take place on Saturday August 15th. Help will be needed on Friday afternoon for set up and on both Saturday and Sunday for the sale. Contact Patrick to volunteer.

Bonnie updated our Youth Protection plan. There is a new system for tracking who has provided a criminal record check and who has completed Youth Protection training. There are also new guidelines for renewal of these two required items. Bonnie noted that there are some kinks in the system, so she is working through which members have completed the record check and the training.

Ev Boegh requested weekly support to help with the Food Share program. Help is needed Thursday mornings from 08:00 to 10:00.

Patrick is planning the next shredding event following our remarkably successful July shredding : we raised \$8,150! The next shredding event will likely be in September and in a location in the south end of Nanaimo. Experience says that our shredding clients live near our shredding location, so the south end should be an untapped area for collection.

Anna let us know that she will be posting a monthly President's report on our website, but did give us the short version for August commenting on events of the Club and that World Community Service is providing \$9,400 to the Guatemala Food project.

Denise L suggested that Zoom meetings allows us to have speakers who are remote (so could not be a speaker in-person). Denise is asking that members invite speakers who are resident elsewhere but would bring valuable insights to our meetings. Make arrangements for this with Denise.

Ken H encouraged members to get involved with the Reimagine Nanaimo project. This allows each of us to provide ideas and suggestions for community development and better services throughout our City including services to support mental health and anti-racism. Participation is through getinvolvednanaimo.ca

Dave Thompson is working towards the Cheese Sale, currently planned as a 30-day sales period starting September 30th (or thereabouts).

Our Rotary lunch picnic is planned for Sunday August 30th. This will likely be held at May Bennett park (behind the north-end rugby fields). The picnic will be a "bring your own everything" event

The meeting then concluded with no fines, reciting the 4-way test, and our goodbye's.
