Patrick reported that 80% of the items were sold at the Blank garage sale and some of the bigger items are still being marketed online. Doug and Daryl picked up some of the smaller unsold items after the weekend and delivered to other various charities in town. The Blank family expressed their gratitude to our club in helping to clear out the house in order to sell it.

**Guest Speaker Don Bonner**

Councilor Bonner gave us an update on the city's response to the homeless situation in our city. A city task force was set up about a year ago to gather information and report to city council with recommendations. Receipt of the final report was delayed by Covid but is expected to be completed in October of this year. The city is hoping to set up a governance structure to effectively work with the many not-for-profit organizations already dealing with the issues contributing to homelessness issues including affordable housing, addictions and mental health.

Don says the most recent city census estimates that 455 are living on the street in Nanaimo, although the RCMP suggest this number is closer to 600. About 30% are First Nation. On a per capita basis the homeless rate is one of the highest in B.C. The temporary facilities at Labieux and Townsite will be dismantled and rebuilt as permanent structures. Don advises that there were some challenges in both locations and in future the city wants to ensure that all residents move through the system and are not just "warehoused".
