*Meeting Notes - Sept 2nd, 2020 by Randall Taylor, photos from Jodi Rogers.*

President Anna opened our Zoom meeting, as we have moved away from in-person meetings to meet Covid regulations. This morning we had 25 participants at the meeting.

Guests this morning included Assistant District Governor Wayne Anderson, and our guest speaker Stephen Cochrane from the Big Brothers big Sisters organization.

Ken Hammer provided a Rotary moment focusing on the 10 things every Rotarian should know about Youth Exchange. This was an excerpt from the recent Rotarian magazine.

**Announcements:**

- Our clubs bottle drive on August 29<sup>th</sup> raised approximately \$1,500.
- Cathy Graham reminded club members of the blueberry picking event. Check your club email for details.
- The Food Share program will continue through to March of 2021. Volunteers are needed every Thursday morning for this program, See Ev Boegh for details and to volunteer.
- There will be a survey of club members to determine a worthy memorial for Ron Blank; and to determine interest for in-person meetings at the Nanaimo Golf Club.
- Our club needs to create a fund-raising event to offset our always successful Christmas Auction. The usual pub event will not happen this year. Send suggestions to President Anna.
- Tyler Vaughan let us know that the World Community Service group has approved a project which sends crop seeds to farmers in Nepal. This will happen in spring 2021. This project is lead by the Lakewood club in Washington and a Rotary club in Nepal.
- San is working on establishing a Food Bank as a permanent organization in Nepal. This will involve multiple Rotary districts.
- Rod Mont provided an opportunity to support the sponsorship of a Syrian family living here in Nanaimo. The extended family is living in a refugee camp in Lebanon and cannot return to Syria. There has been \$17,000 raised to bring the extended family to Canada however \$16,000 more is needed. Rod and Jill will match donation of club funds for this effort.
- There was discussion of participation in Rotary Youth Exchange for the year 2021/ 2022. More information will be coming after the 5 club Presidents and ADG Anderson discuss the issues.

**Presentation:** Stephen Cochrane of Big Brothers, Big Sisters was our presenter.

- Our club has supported the big Brothers, Big Sisters organization most recently through our "Clippers" 50/50 funds.
- The Big Brothers, Big Sisters organization is changing its branding and mission statement to: "Empowering Youth and Igniting Potential". Their purpose is to enable life-changing mentoring relationships to ignite the power and potential of young people.
- Stephen stated that \$1 invested in mentoring returns \$23 to society in benefits; financial literacy, good life choices, healthy lifestyles, higher likelihood of employment, and more likely to developed in leadership positions.
- Gaming Funds, which help fund big Brothers, Big Sisters, are reduced due to Covid 19. These are restarting now, however the organization is asking Rotary clubs for commitment to provide volunteers or funds for specific programs.
- Last year, in our area, there were over 220 young people working with over 100 mentors. As for volunteers, 40% of mentors are age 55+.
- Contact Stephen to become a volunteer or mentor. the ultimate goal is to "develop relationships and support youth".

The meeting then concluded with Ev B winning the draw, Bill Hardy fining only himself. We then recited the 4-way test, and our goodbyes.
