  - ◆ Anna – discussed at the last board meeting, it is hard to connect by zoom. Likes hands on projects, which is difficult. Janice Krall has ideas for fundraising, online auctions for Christmas.

  - ◆ San – Nepal – walk for Nepal, legacy is long term food bank with a goal of \$60,000 from all the clubs.

- 1975 graduated from Cowichan High – then 5yrs at UVic working towards his teaching degree

- Worked in bars/hotels while at UVic and wound up managing the Surfside in Victoria – and through the years bought and owned nightclubs as it was in his wheelhouse and at 33yrs old sold and got into the concrete business.
- In the concrete business, he started washing trucks and worked his way up and then moved to Kelowna and met his wife Karen and ended up moving back to Abbotsford.
- In 1996, 1st child was born. Within 5yrs, they had 4 kids and got married at 42yrs of age.
- 2001, moved to Nanaimo and Rotary was involved in the Parkway Challenge, which Mayco Mix sponsored, so Denise Larson introduced Doug to Rotary and he has not left.
- Has met many great people in Rotary over the last 18yrs. His presidency went way to quick and with Covid19, it made it more interesting.
- Ended his talk with – Be nice to people.
- A little story from Doug. His mom 85yrs of age does not speak good English. She does not believe in banks and has stuffed money everywhere through the house where the 4 boys have to gather the cash and split it between the grandchildren. There was a broken chair that Doug had to throw out for his mom. In the meantime, Mom had a dream where her husband spoke to her and said to check the chair for money. Sure enough \$20,000 was stuffed in the chair....
