 - Employment Keep it - wrapped up 3yr contract and had a successful run
 - 2017-2020 – 154 employed and 10 back to school / special training
 - Employment keep it with programs in construction, culinary, tourism and hospitality, personal care companion
 - Blade Runners Program – 43 intakes, 77% average rate of employment and 450 youth served in a 3yr period
 - NYSA - partnered with Central Vancouver Island Multicultural Society to offer its new diverse futures program.
 - New initiatives - partnering with a local driving school to get youth driving and leverage youth into better paying employment. Rent Smart - allows youth to learn rights and responsibilities as renters
- ⇒ **Paul Harris Award** - Doug Pearson was presented with his 5th Paul Harris. Rod will set up a time with Doug to present it to him in person.
- ⇒ **50/50 - #16** was the number - Jodi Rogers was our lucky winner.
- ⇒ **Sgt at arms** - Bill H - fined president Anna for last weeks meeting cutting the meeting short and not allowing the Sgt at Arms any time to fine anyone.
