Meeting Notes - Nov 18th, 2020 by Jodi Rogers, photos from Jodi Rogers.

This Zoom meeting was opened by President Anna. The majority of muted members stood and sang O Canada while Rod accompanied on the saxophone.

Patrick Maguire said **Invocation**.

Ken Hammer introduced our **Guests**, being Linda Blank and daughter Debbie, former exchange students, Ayu and Dorien, and Interact members Gracie and Declan.

Rotary Moment was given by San Mahara, who spoke of an article in this month's Rotary magazine reprinted from the March 1933 issue. San told us how, during the Great Depression of 1933, wives of Rotarians, came together to create a soup kitchen which, at one point, fed over 5,000 people in a week. San mentioned that, at that time, women were known by their husband's name only. San ended his moment by stressing the importance of women in Rotary.

Presentation:

Today's presentation was by Interact President Gracie and Vice President Declan. In a heartwarming letter, they said how Ron had been involved with their Interact club for years and would always help with fundraising. To acknowledge how much they appreciated Ron's time and commitment, a \$500 cheque was presented in support of Polio Plus in honour of Ron's memory.

President Anna spoke about Cindy Perez, the Guatemalan student who our club will be sponsoring in memory of Ron Blank. Cindy, is an exceptional student, earning grades in the high 90s-100. The high school Cindy will be attending specializes in computer technology. Cindy will be starting an Interact Club in her home town of Pebeo. The cost of sponsoring Cindy will be \$480 per year and we have committed to sponsoring her throughout high school.

Anna also spoke of the memorial bench for Ron at Cottonwood Golf Club and also the whale tail bench which Doug Lum was able to have donated and which Doug is hoping to have installed at Rotary Centennial Park adorned with a memorial plaque for Ron.

Ken informed the Club that Ron had made provision in his Will to leave \$2,000 to Rotary International, that ReMax had donated \$500 towards the Blank's garage sale and that proceeds from the furniture sale were to be donated to our Club. Also, thanks to Ron's investment suggestion, our club is expecting +/- \$20,000 from Harbour City Bingo.
