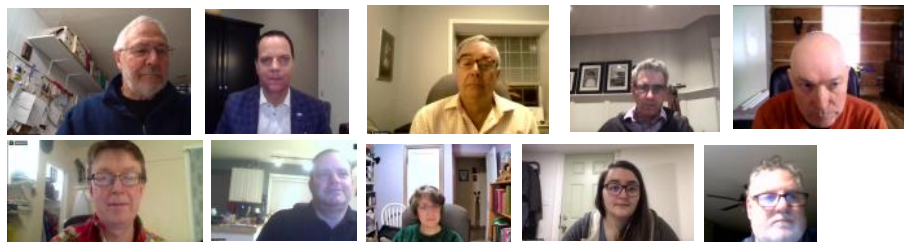

Club 25th Anniversary Project

Ken Hammer advised that that a committee including himself, Ev Boegh, Denise Larson and Patrick Maguire recommend we host a walk/run/bike event similar to our Parkway Challenge Event held in 1997. We will include 25 NPO's in our community to participate in the fundraiser.
