Jeff Boegel gave us the history of the "4 Way test" and the motto "Service above self".

Guest Speaker

Craig Gillis, former DG of our district, gave the following statistics:

Rotary is in 200 countries, there are currently 36,996 clubs, 1.2 million Rotarians and 535 Districts in the world. Our District, 5020, straddles Vancouver Island and western Washington state. There are 92 clubs in our District, 4189 Rotarians and 18 areas. It is the largest District in the Americas. There are 34 zones in the world and we are in zone 27.

Currently there have only been 4 cases of wild polio reported in 2021 in the world. In 2020 there were 140. Pakistan has been polio free for 240 days, but to be considered eradicated it has to be polio free in a country for 3 years.

The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation will match 2 dollars for every dollar funded by Rotary.

The three "buckets of funds" at Rotary Foundation are Polio Plus, the Annual Fund and the Endowment Fund.

Craig advised that, in future, the District Community Grants available to a club will be impacted by the club per capita Rotary Foundation contributions. If you have any questions regarding your Foundation account there is a Rotary Help Desk 1-866-976-8279.
