- Started to work in the field of ending sex trafficking in Reno- stories of women such as one who was sold off by their father at age 8 to pay off a debt
- Julie brought business skills to groups that helps people get out of the sex trade "Awaken" in Reno, and then moved to Seattle and was involved with "Real Escape from the Sex Trade"
- Numbers are shocking
