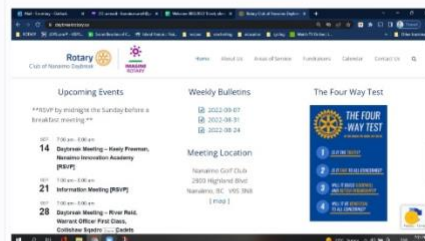
In Person Meetings Taking Place!!!...

There are 5 very, very, very easy steps. You must RSVP before midnight the Sunday before the next meeting.

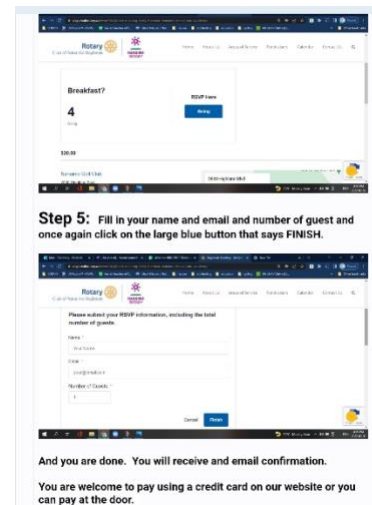
Step 1: Go to <https://www.daybreakrotary.ca/> Which is our club website. Most of you should have been there at least once by now.
