Where: Visitor Centre Parking lot at Northfield and Parkway When: Meet and Check in time: 9:15 am - Waivers are available for download at the www.rotaryinnanaimo.com website. If you are a Team Captain you can bring all of your Team's signed waivers with you when you check in and they can go directly to your pick up site. Individuals not already part of a team check in onsite, sign the Waiver and then will be added to an existing team or be assigned a pickup location. What is provided: Pickup location maps.
