Again no reminders are sent for breakfast, please book ahead.

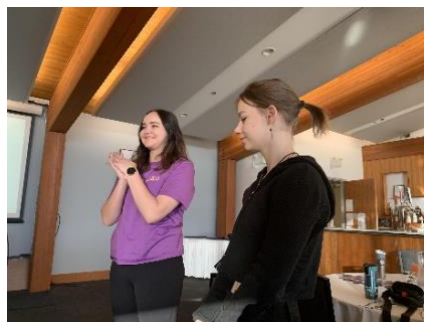
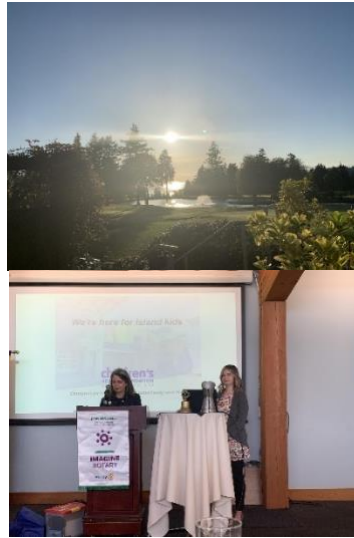
Bottles of wine are needed for the golf tournament, as well as prizes.
