Doug Lum introduced our **Guest Speaker Rob Hunter** of the Nanaimo Clippers. Rob asked "what is behind what they do". The path to the NHL is changing. NCAA is becoming much more popular. Players coming in from across North America and streaming to NCAA, 40% go this route. Attendance is recovering, up 41.5% since 2021-2022. Sponsorship is up 39% as well and is seeing growth and works hard to meet the \$1.5 million annual budget. New owners are excellent team managers and have been able to start donating back into the community. New players coming up one of whom is being scouted by NHL and another who is excited to be part of the community. Billeting is a big part of having these players here and are always looking for billet families. Some of our 50-50 \$ have gone to loaves and fishes, Snuneymuxw indigenous basketball, 205 Air Cadet quadron, Salvation Army, etc etc
