Kris led the Introduction of Visiting Rotarians and Guests. Today we enjoyed the company of Greg Devenish, the current president of Lantzville Rotary, Liam Egan, and Dr. Chidum Anyanwu.



Ken introduced our **Guest Speaker Greg Devenish**. Greg told us lots about the Vancouver Island Military Museum https://militarymuseum.ca/ which is located between the Port Theatre and Port Place Mall. Greg said that everything in the museum is about people and their stories. The goal of the museum is to remind people about the role of the Canadian military both while at war and in peace. The museum was founded in 1986 and moved to its present location in 2010. The hours of operation are 10 -3 Tuesday - Friday and 11 - 3 on Saturdays. The museum is also available upon request. It is entirely run by volunteers. Greg concluded his presentation with a "show and tell" of some of the items that are stored at the museum.
