Graham introduced Quinlyn King who works with the Nanaimo Clippers. Quinlyn is looking for eight families to host from September to May. Host families get a stipend of \$600 per month and seasons tickets.

Our guest speaker was Mic McDaniel, a Tacoma South Rotarian who joined us by Zoom. Mic was introduced by Karin and his topic was Community Health Workers in India. There is a Rotary District project which trains Community Health Workers ("CHWs"). CHWs do many things including providing non-emergency care, training in hygiene and disease prevention, creating and maintaining health records, assisting in midwifery, and obtaining birth certificates. Many villages in India do not have any trained support. This project has worked with 20 villages in Northern India. In addition to doing the basic training for CHWs, basic first aid kits are being purchased and future work might include working with malnutrition.

Jodi did the 50/50 which was won by Rob Dodds. Duane collected lots of money with fines and happy bucks.
