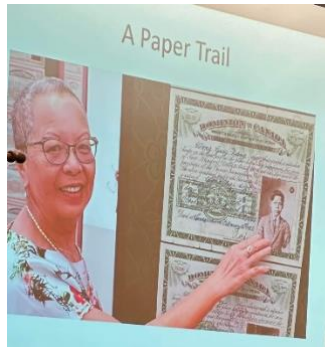
Meeting Notes – November 1st, 2023 by Hailey Poirier, photos by Cathy Manson

Sergeant in Arms - Duane called breakfast order

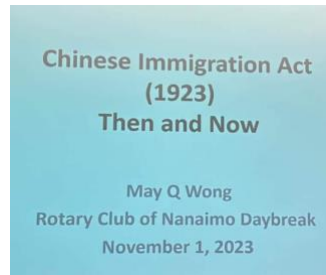
Nelson updated the Club that November is Foundation month - a table will be set up to
