President Dave Thompson chaired the meeting. Rod Mont played O Canada. Zel provided Inspiration of saying "I wish you well" to other people beside you in the room.

Graham Introduced his guest Max as "The Guest Paddler", and also our three international visiting students, Alex, Fonda, and Antosia.



Graham also showed a slide for the Rotary Moment describing the origin of the 24 words that make up The 4-Way Test. (Cathy Manson has a picture of the slide, and will post it on the Facebook page).

Daryl Knievel, as Sergeant at Arms, assigned tables.

Dave Thompson told us of his recent trip to Maui, north of Lahaina, of the fires there, and how it will take years to rebuild. Some friends of his lost their home. Some US "vultures" were trying to buy land from locals.

Today's meeting theme was around more communication and was called "Spotlighting".

Rick spoke of donating to The Foundation on our website. Denise L asked: "What is Foundation?", to which Rick replied: "these donations fund the bigger projects, like the eradication of Polio."

Bonnie then showed a short video about Foundation Month, highlighting "Giving Tuesday".

Continuing with Spotlighting, Graham told of the Nanaimo Clippers 50/50 draws, which have been going on now for 8 years. The Clippers receive 25% of the proceeds, and our Club now takes up to \$20,000 per year. Over the past 2 years, we have received \$45,000! Both Graham and Doug L. are well-liked by The Clippers organization. Our Club has donated \$12,000 to the colonoscopy lab, monies to the First Nations Basketball Tournament, and others.

Graham also mentioned that he needs volunteers for 3 months while he is away to sell 50/50 tickets at Clippers games (Friday evenings and Sunday afternoons), and to pick up, sort, and deliver bottles to Recycling Depot.

For our Friendship Exchange, District 9400 in South Africa is sending 12 people to us in June, 2024. Volunteers are needed to accommodate each couple for 3-4 nights.

Doug L talked about the 3 Book Boxes that are set up around town. Doug collects books weekly and delivers them to Literacy Nanaimo. He regularly collects hundreds of pounds of books! The books are sorted by Literacy Nanaimo staff, and the ones they djon't use are donated to the Rotary Book Sale. Last year, the Book Sale generated \$129,000!

Bonnie also mentioned that Literacy Nanaimo accepts computer tablets, repairs them where necessary, and donates them to people who need them.

Mike G. addressed our group about our upcoming "Hamperville Social" on November 28th. "Ready to go! Need a few more volunteers." Ticket sales are now open on website. Cathy M. urged everyone to bring wine for the "Wine Wagon" to be drawn at the dinner. Don't forget: "NO CRAP!!" Donna urged people who are bringing baked goods to use disposable plates, and to bring them on the night of the event. Zel and Cathy M. are having a Table Decorations get-together at Cathy's house (6191 Garside Road) at 7pm on November 27th. Help not needed!
