Today's guests were Carolyn Russell, the Associate Vice President, International Affairs at VIU, Sungchul Choi, Dean of Management at VIU, and Val Cunningham who will soon be a member of Daybreak Rotary.

For the Rotary moment, Cathy M. told us that she and Scott have now been in Rotary for one year. They enjoy the incredible people, everyone's willingness to help, and the huge teamwork. We are grateful to have them as members.

Donna told us about a visit to the Rotary Club of Singapore that she and Nelson recently attended. The Rotary International Convention will be held in Singapore this May. They enjoyed seeing a dragon dance at the meeting and exchanged our club's banner with Singapore Rotary.

Ev reminded us of the Chamber Business Expo happening March 28. She is looking for volunteers to man a Rotary booth. There will also be a big trash pickup day coming in April. Ken announced that Rotaract is having an event on March 9 to celebrate International Women's Day.

Ken introduced our guest speakers Carolyn Russell and Sungchul Choi. They discussed the international students at VIU. Currently 11% of the student population is indigenous and 12% of the student population are international students. VIU is aiming to have 17% of the student population to be international. There are about 1,500 international students right now at VIU from 76 countries. The primary countries are India, China, Nigeria, Vietnam, Ghana, and Iran. More than half of these students are in the Faculty of Management. VIU also has global partnerships in 52 countries. One thing that has been in the news lately is the federal government's IRCC cap on international student study permits. VIU got a good allocation with a small lift over last year. It was noted that the graduate students and students studying for less than six months are exempt from this cap.
