Hullo expects to transport 1 million passengers every year. Their office is at 10 Church Street in Nanaimo (near Modern Café). Hullo has built their reputation on Safety First, Innovation, and Service Excellence. Some features

include: High speed WIFI on board, reservable seats on board, only 20-minute pre-boarding wait time, complimentary shuttle from Coast Bastion Hotel, Bus Exchange at Port Place Mall to Hullo Terminal, Late night sailings to accommodate Canucks games and concerts in Vancouver, 12-14 sailings per day. Staff have backgrounds in the Hotel Business, Hospitality Industry, and all are Marine Safety trained. Hullo partnered with Snuneymuxw First Nations, The Port Authority, and The Vancouver Harbour Flight Centre for their operations both here and in Vancouver. Xander gave a few hints as to what is being planned for the future: Group Rates for sports and conferences, Frequent Travellers discounts, fleet expansion, expansion to include service from Victoria, and a Referral Program.
