The money that is raised goes towards items that are needed and not typically funded, like warming blankets, vein finders, hospital machinery, birthing beds and NICU needs and so much more. They also help support the Jr Hospital volunteers. This is a group of students who are considering health care as their chosen career. Fun fact, in 1952, the Auxiliary cookbook had the first ever recipe for Nanaimo Bar in it. Their funds are raised through the gift shop, thrift store, craft group sales, 50/50 staff lottery, and small cash donations. They make and donate a terrific amount of money to the Hospital. The NEED currently is volunteers. They are REALLY desperate for volunteers. They are BUSY at the Thrift store and would really appreciate anyone who can help. There are volunteers forms Available and the website (nrghauxiliary.org) also has a volunteer intake on it.



Rob D. is the latest grad of the VI Leadership group and his team created a presentation about Fraud Prevention that was truly informative.
