He was fortunate because schooling is free to students in Nigeria, including medical school and internship. His perception of himself was a struggle as a young man, because of a physical challenge that he developed. He received advice from professionals, had a very long surgery and it all helped him immensely. This experience taught him perseverance and made him who he is today. He moved to Ireland and then, moved to Canada. Today, Tunde is a distinguished Pathologist. What
