↑ The Story Behind the Walk

The Walk for Nepal began ten years ago, in response to the **devastating 2015 earthquake** that struck Nepal, leaving over **1 million children without classrooms**. What started as a grassroots initiative to rebuild schools has grown into a powerful, community led effort that continues to create meaningful change across Nepal.

Since its inception, the Rotary Club of Nanaimo Daybreak, together with generous supporters like you and global Rotary partners has raised over \$150,000 USD. These funds have:

- Rebuilt classrooms and educational infrastructure
- Served over 100,000 hot meals during the COVID-19 lockdown
- Delivered safe drinking water to remote communities
- Funded **vocational programs** for individuals with disabilities
- Provided free dental care in rural villages
- In November 2024, I had the privilege of leading a team of Canadian dental professionals, 3 dentists and 3 dental assistants, to provide free dental care to more than 800 people in rural
